Bloom360 Findings

National Research*

Nine out of ten teachers nationwide believe social and emotional skills can be taught and that it benefits students.

Students demonstrate better problem-solving skills in PBL than in more traditional classes and are able to apply what they learn to real-life situations.

Supporting students' SEL development produces an **11% gain in grades and test scores**. Studies show that social and emotional competency is more predictive of academic and career achievement than IQ.

Growth in occupations that require mastery of social and emotional skills has outpaced growth of all other occupations. **Eight in 10 employers say social and emotional skills are the most important** and yet also the hardest skills to find.



Meaningful moments underscore the importance of providing Learners with the right environment, a trusted team of guides and high-interest opportunities to encourage growth. These moments add up to powerful stories of perseverance, self confidence, and unlocking options for their futures.

Trusted adults who take the time to know you, listen to you and understand you is vital in feeling safe and ready to learn.



Sharing joy with super dog Stella after making her a comfy dog bed as a project. (Notice Stella's paw and appreciative gaze.) Schoolwork doesn't have to be memorization and worksheets.



If Saturn is your favorite planet, a customized Solar System project with homemade lava rocks is the ideal launching pad for learning.



Weekly therapeutic riding at nearby Willow Creek Ranch is a favorite activity and also supports Learners' physical, social-emotional and academic growth.



Learners complete an average of 10 school-wide projects each year to practice collaboration, planning, teamwork, communication and entrepreneurship. These are critical skills employers report are the hardest to find.



The only school in southeastern Wisconsin with a full-time music therapist, Learners enjoy individualized music therapy and two annual showcase concerts where they plan the entire program.
